Our topic in nursery this half term is festivals and celebrations.

Physical Development:

- Christmas dancing for parties and concerts.
- Action songs linked to Bonfire night and Christmas.
- Holding scissors and a pencil correctly.

Mathematics:

- Sing lots of number songs and rhymes.
- Practise counting out objects.
- Setting the table for a party. Sharing out sweets or food.
- Games to help number recognition to 5.

There are lots of ways you can help your child at home!

<u>Literacy</u>

- Practise writing their name.
- Write a letter to Santa or make a list.
- Variety of stories and rhymes about different celebrations.

Understanding the World:

- Stories and activities about Bonfire night and Christmas.
- Investigate other festivals and celebrations e.g.— Diwali.

Communication and Language

- Joining in with chants, songs and stories.
- Talk about and describe traditions and celebrations.
- Practising Christmas or firework songs.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- Play games together to develop turn taking skills. Encourage the importance of sharing and giving.
- Discuss how other people might be feeling and why.

Expressive Arts and Design:

- Experiment with a variety of art materials to make your own Christmas or Diwali cards..
- Make some decorations to go in the house.
- Listen to, and join in with some festive songs.
