







RE - Knowledge Organiser for unit; 'What can we learn about Christianity by visiting a church?'

Font		Used to baptise babies and people joining the Christian community
Lecturn		Used by the vicar to rest the Bible on when he is giving a sermon.
Candle		Used to help people remember that God is the light of the world
Stained Glass Window		Has beautiful pictures of stories from the Bible
Organ		Used to accompany the people in the church when they are singing hymns.
Altar		A special place where the vicar will bless the bread and wine for the Communion.

Worship - Christians worship by **praying**, **singing** or visiting a **special place - church**.

Leader - Christian churches have a leader called a **Reverend**.

Bible - Special **book** to Christians.

God - Christians believe God **created** the world and everything in it.

Jesus - Christians believe He is **God's** son sent to earth to spread God's messages.
