	Seaham, England	Rio de Janeiro, Brazil
Location	Seaham is a town in our local area. It is situated on the coast in the north east of England, near the North Sea. England is a country in Europe.	Rio de Janeiro is a city in Brazil. It is situated on the east coast of Brazil near the Atlantic Ocean. Brazil is located in South America.
Landmarks	In Seaham, you could see the famous Tommy statue, the beaches, the lighthouse, the harbour cafes, shops and the pier.	In Rio De Janeiro, you could see Christ the Redeemer, Copacabana Beach or Sugar Loaf Mountain. Further away, you could visit the Amazon Rainforest or Iguazu Falls.
Weather	The temperatures in Seaham range between 6°C and 19°C and the average sea temperature is 10°C. It is almost 4000 miles away from the equator.	In Rio De Janeiro temperatures range between 25°C and 30°C and their average sea temperature is 23°C. It is just south of the equator.
