Introduction

Our Breakfast Club was formed for the purpose to offer a service to parents who want, for whatever reason to drop their children at school before the opening of the usual school day. The club provides children with opportunities to eat their breakfast and play in a relaxed and supportive atmosphere. Due to funding we are able to offer our provision free of charge to school aged children. This is reviewed annually.

Times and Places

Doors open for Breakfast Club at 8:00am for school children and 8.15a..m for nursery children. Last entry into school is 8.30am.

Children both eat and play in the dining hall and use the toilet facilities in Class 7.

Breakfast Club will only be open when the school is open ie they will not operate on inset days.

Staff

There are three Breakfast Club staff who feed and supervise the children. School staff are always on site if needed. A third member of staff is often brought in when numbers rise. All Breakfast Club staff have enhanced DBS.

Attendance

Attendance is voluntary, children attend on a casual basis.

Food

A selection of cereals, fruit, bagels and pancakes are always available. Drinks include milk, water and fruit juice.

Charging

Membership is free, this is reviewed annually.

Behaviour

It is expected that all children will be polite and well behaved at all times.
