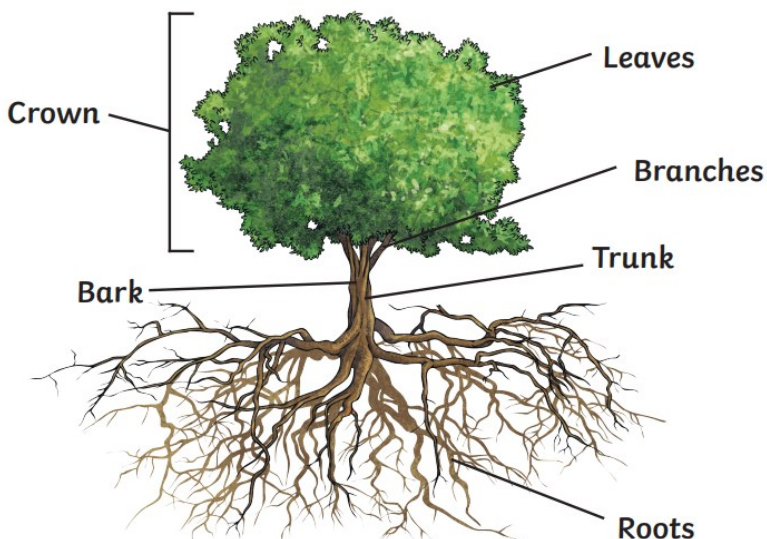
### Key Knowledge - Plants

Plant	A living thing that usually grows from the ground.
Main parts of a plant	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Flower</li> <li>• Leaf</li> <li>• Stem</li> <li>• Root</li> </ul>
Common plants to identify	Tulips, daffodils, roses, bluebells, lavender, peonies, foxgloves

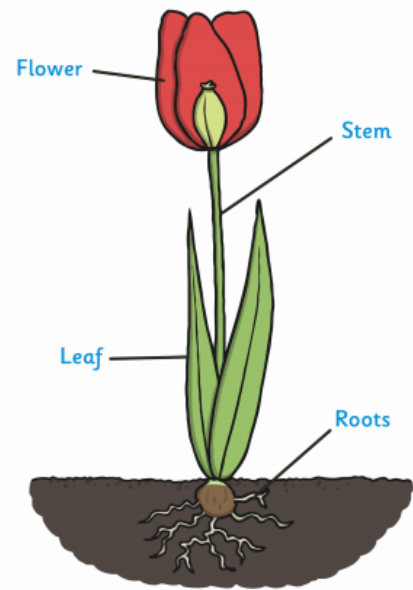
### Key Knowledge - Trees

Main parts of a tree	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Roots</li> <li>• Trunk</li> <li>• Leaves</li> <li>• Branches</li> <li>• Crown</li> </ul>
Common trees to identify	Ash, beech, birch, maple, oak, sycamore, holly

### Key Vocabulary

Seed	The part of a flowering plant that can develop into a new plant.
Flower	Brightly coloured to attract insects who bring pollen from other flowers.
Stem	Holds the plant upright and transports water around the plant.
Leaf	Turns sunlight into food and energy for the plant.
Roots	Absorb water and minerals from the soil.
Evergreen	A tree that keeps its leaves all year.
Deciduous	A tree that loses its leaves in the Autumn and grows new ones in the Spring.
